At orientation, you'll take a tour, fill out a volunteer application, and learn about tasks and open shifts.

Volunteer Shifts at the CSC are:

- Every Monday, Wednesday, and Friday: 8 am. to 12:15 pm. and 11:45 am. to 4 pm.
- Every Tuesdays: 8:30 am. to 4:30 pm.
- 2nd and 4th Wednesdays: 4:30 pm. to 7:15 pm.

At the CSC, volunteers sort and stock food items, greet and help clients, and work in the Food Rescue kitchen.

Volunteer Shifts at the WDC are:

• Every Tuesdays and Wednesdays: 9 am. to Noon, and 1 pm. to 4 pm.

During these shifts, volunteers pack food bags, sort food drive items, re-pack bulk food, and more.
